






FINANCIAL REPORT

Update on Giving

Tithes and Offering received for the month of July:	\$11,513.00
Amount needed to meet budget:	\$11,000
Per Budget through July:	(\$1,739.54)
Open Collections:	\$750.75
Pastors Fund (July):	\$1,700.00
Salaries and Expenses Paid (July):	\$16,943.93

As a reminder, the budget that the church passed in January was a deficit budget (\$5,530) and that included receiving South Providence Neighborhood Matters' rent and telephone expense reimbursements.

Thank you to all who contributed to the deficit/Pastor's fund over the past few months. The total received as of July 30, 2017 is \$21,931. We needed \$27,500 to balance the budget and continue to pay the pastor full time for 2017 **so we are still short \$5,569.**

We received 3 proposals for the flat roof repair, have accepted Robinson Roofing, Inc.'s proposal of \$15,500. The work was completed on August 11th, and Robinson Roofing has been paid-in-full, using money received from the building fund donations and 5 months of invested fund's monthly distribution. We needed to request \$5,000 from the investment funds for the final payment

National Grid has started billing us for the Electric upgrades and this adds \$595.88 per month to their invoices on top of each month's billing for usage. This contract is for 2 years.

Thank you to all who have been faithful in their tithes and offering giving. Please continue through the summer vacation months to keep your offerings up-to-date. Our Church home's bills do not take a vacation! The below information may be helpful.

On-line tithes and offering:

Do you pay your bills on-line? If you do, you are saving the cost of stamps/envelopes and the convenience of not having to write out checks each month. If you would like to give your tithes and offering on-line, call your bank to give you a login for on-line access to your checking account. There should not be a bank fee for this service.

Once you have on-line access to your account, click on "add a bill" and follow the instructions to add Calvary Baptist Church, 747 Broad St, Providence, RI 02907 telephone #401-461-7507. When it asks for an account number, use your envelope number. If you have not been assigned an envelope number, call Martha, the Administrative Assistant at 461-7507 or email Betty Cady, Treasurer at eac811@cox.net.

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Jesus asked, *“What will it profit them if they gain the whole world but forfeit their life? Or what will they give in return for their life?”* (Matthew 16:26). He was saying that nothing else can compare with the value of life itself. Christians, especially know this is true, since we believe our spiritual journey will last far beyond our physical journey. We have been entrusted with the assurance that death does not end the gift of life but is the door, to life everlasting.

John recorded the assurance that Jesus gave his disciples – and us – as the trial of the crucifixion neared: *“In my Father’s house there are many dwelling places. If it were not so, would I have told you that I go to prepare a place for you? And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again and will take you to myself, so that where I am, there you may be also?”* (John 14:2-3)

The essence of God is love, and God’s gift of Christ came from the center of that love. Jesus gave his life because he loved us. If we, as Christians, are to reflect our loving and wonderful God and our loving, crucified, and resurrected Savior, then should not love be the basis for what we give? This type of giving goes beyond percentages, pledges, tax deductions, and all the other motivations for giving found in our culture and economic systems. It is love that produces sacrificial giving.

First, the tithe is not an appropriate standard for giving in an affluent society. The tithe is a rather easy rule to follow and, by following it, the more stringent demands of giving are ignored.

Second, God’s demands are far greater than the tithe, a 10% token of one’s possessions.

Third, the tithe, for an affluent Christian, holds no opportunity for sacrifice. The tithe in an affluent society is no more than a charitable deduction.

Fourth, the tithe talks only about money. Giving should not be tied only to money.

The essential points to keep in mind about tithing are the following:

- Everything we have is from God.
- We are called to be good stewards of all that God has entrusted to us.
- In responding to the challenge of Christian stewardship in every area of life, we are called to shape decisions about our personal finances, in light of God’s claim on our lives.
- Tithing can provide a biblical, practical, timely giving guideline for Christian disciples.

(STEWARDSHIP CONTINUED)

Tithing is a discipleship issue not a fund-raising device. It is about our relationship to Jesus Christ. The question tithing raises is not “how much of the church’s budget is my share,” but rather, “how much of my income is God’s share.” We have a need to give, and the tithe is a guide in addressing that need.

Giving makes me more like God. *“God so loved the world that he gave his only begotten son”*. John 3:16
