Calvary Baptist Emergency Food Pantry Blessings ~

God has blessed the church with a once per month food pantry distribution that has fed more than 18,000 people since its inception four years ago! If that isn't amazing enough what has made this food pantry work for the people who live in the Southside of Providence is the awesome volunteers and donors who have generously contributed to this ministry and who care about food insecurity of others.

We can agree that the coronavirus pandemic has brought so many challenges for everyone. While we are all in the same boat, we are not all experiencing the pandemic in the same way. An important early partnership with Calvary's food ministry is with Donald DePetrillo owner of The Original Italian Bakery in Johnston. Donald has been faithfully donating delicious baked goods since the food pantry began in 2018. The food pantry clients look forward to freshly baked bread, rolls, sweet treats and of course Donald's famous pizza chips.

Another important Calvary partnership is with John Santos owner of Urban Greens Co-op Market on Cranston Street in Providence. Calvary was connected to John when the Providence Mayor's Healthy Community Office was working on food insecurity issues led by Ellen Cynar. Carol Hall-Walker a member of Calvary and at the time, working at the RI Department of Health connected. Both ladies were involved in addressing food insecurity. During the height of the pandemic the Mayor's Office wanted Urban Greens to help feed people for 6 to 8 weeks on the southside of Providence. Rachel Bloe Calvary's leader of the emergency food pantry worked with Carol and Ellen in establishing a community partnership with John Santos. Rachel and John both care about making community connections and helping people understand that they are welcome in places they may think they are not welcome. Afterall, a core value of Urban Greens is equal access to healthy and nutritious food. A business partnership began in 2019.

John was excited to connect with Calvary because he understood that sometimes you must bring the store to the community for people to understand that this type of store is for them too. Many in the community thought Urban Greens was like Whole Foods and they didn't think the store was for them. With connections made to people like Rachel and other like-minded people, John began to see a shift in people from the community feeling comfortable and coming into Urban Greens.

John said, "when organizations like Urban Greens, the YMCA, Federal Hill House and Calvary Baptist Church folks roll up their sleeves and work together change happens in the community. It has been rewarding and it changed how we do business. We began living up to our equal access mission and diversifying. Working with Calvary and other community-based agencies, we diversified our outreach. Our staff feel good about building relationships with community members. You don't need to know everyone, just a few good people who are connected to the community. This has made all the difference. It has been good for my staff and really for everyone involved."

Several other churches such as, Philips Memorial in Cranston, Greenville Baptist in Greenville, Central Baptist church in Jamestown and of course the many dedicated Urban Green volunteers, Calvary members and the new Calvary Pastor Geneva Urquhart, have all helped make the food pantry a success.
